Stock Truck Pull Classes

4x4 6,500 lb open gas engine
 4x4 8,500 lb open diesel engine
 4x4 Stock or dually stock

Keep in mind the safety of the crowd and yourself when operating your machine. Judges have the right to stop and disqualify any machine not being operated safely. All units will be inspected by two or more judges in the presence of the owners for safety or rule violation. Violations of any rule shall constitute a disqualification. All units limited to one class only. Enter at your own risk!

Antique Rules- all tractors must be a model built pre 1950 with factory stock engine and components, no home builds, 19" drawbar height, extended minimum 18" back and stable during pull, no cut or sharpened tires, chains, steel wheels, front drives, four wheel drives, crawlers, or duals, Engine must be controlled by throttle or governor factory stock rpm, puller must provide own clevis, Driver must remain seated, Parents must sigh for 14-18 year olds, driver must be on tractor at weigh-in, driver may change gears before reaching the 50' marker, tractor must remain within the course boundaries, Weights may be transferred on tractor but must be done before hooking up, weights will be counted on the scale and recorded on the tractor, weight can be no more than 24" beyond front wheels and 18" behind rear wheels. There must be 6"x6" clearance on center of drawbar.

Farm Tractor Rules-factory stock engines and components only, 20" drawbar height, no cut tires, chains, duals or front drives, rpm can not exceed 2800 maximum rpm, stock injection pumps only, top 3 place winners will be rpm checked, parents must sigh for 14-18 year olds, no one younger than 16 is allowed in turbo classes, driver must be on tractor at weigh-in, Weights may be transferred on tractor but must be done before hooking on, weight may be no more than 24" extended on either end of tractor, there must be a 6"x6" clearance on center of drawbar.

Truck Rules-25" tires maximum, drivers will be weighed with there trucks, any driver under 18 must have written parental consent, all trucks must leave the track area in a safe manner, no weights or weight bar on front, all weights must be in the box, hitch must be in a stock location with a maximum height of 26", 1" minimum of suspension, may restart up to the 75' pull mark 1 time only, first puller has the option of pulling again first or last, if a floating finish is used the side boundary will extend endlessly, all pullers must stop as soon as there are red flagged or be subject to disqualification.
